- Complete all prerequisites with grade of C or higher
- Cumulative Transfer GPA: 2.0 or higher

- MAC 1105 (College Algebra) is not required for this program. Select **MGF or STA** courses that satisfy the AA. If MGF or STA courses are included in the table(s) below, select those.
- **School of International and Public Affairs (SIPA) Foreign Language Requirement:** Complete a second level or higher foreign language course with a grade of C or higher (e.g., French II, Spanish II, ASL II). Passing scores on [credit-by-exam](#) language exams are acceptable. (Completion of a second level course or higher in this program satisfies the SIPA requirement.)
- The additional lower division course below is required for this program. We encourage students to take the course (as an elective) prior to completing the AA.
