- **School of International and Public Affairs (SIPA) Foreign Language Requirement:** Complete a second level or higher foreign language course with a grade of C or higher (e.g., French II, Spanish II, ASL II). Passing scores on [credit-by-exam](#) language exams are acceptable.
- There are no prerequisites for this program. The lower division course below (REL 2300) is required for the degree. We encourage students to take the course (as an elective) prior to completing the AA. The course transfers to FIU as a lower division social science, however, an exception to award REL 3308 is made for Religious Studies majors.
- The strongly recommended courses below deepen discipline knowledge and enhance skills for upper division courses. We encourage students to take courses in the disciplines noted below (as electives) prior to completing the AA.
